The Cardiac Enrolled nurse work under the supervision of a Registered Nurse to care for patients with coronary heart disease, congestive heart failure and other heart diseases, and answers questions, provides education and emotional support for the patient's family.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities of an Enrolled Nurse

- Need to comply and work within his / her scope of practice as prescribed by SANC.
- Care for patients who suffer from conditions that affect their cardiovascular and pulmonary systems.
- Assists with diagnostic tests like electrocardiograms.
- Educates patients on ways to prevent heart disease.
- Knowledge of accepted treatments for patients with cardio-related conditions.
- Must have superior written and verbal communication skills.
- Must have good critical thinking skills and be an active listener.
- Good decision-making skills to exercise sound judgment are necessary.
- Must have excellent complex problem-solving skills.
- Knowledge of cardiopulmonary resuscitation or CPR techniques
- Must be detail oriented.
- Must have good leadership skills.
- Knowledge of all cardiovascular and cardiopulmonary equipment.
- Ability to function as an effective member of the nursing team.
- Ability to communicate effectively with all patients and health professionals.
- Willingness to work shifts in accordance with the requirements of the unit.
- Committed to continuous self-development.
- Well-developed interpersonal skills.
- A strong customer service orientation and commitment to quality care.

- Current registration with SANC as a Enrolled Nurse.
- Minimum 2 -3 years post-qualification experience with a proven track record in a private hospital.
- BLS certified.
