Our Newsletter is meant to keep you in the loop and I am looking forward sharing all of these with you in future editions.

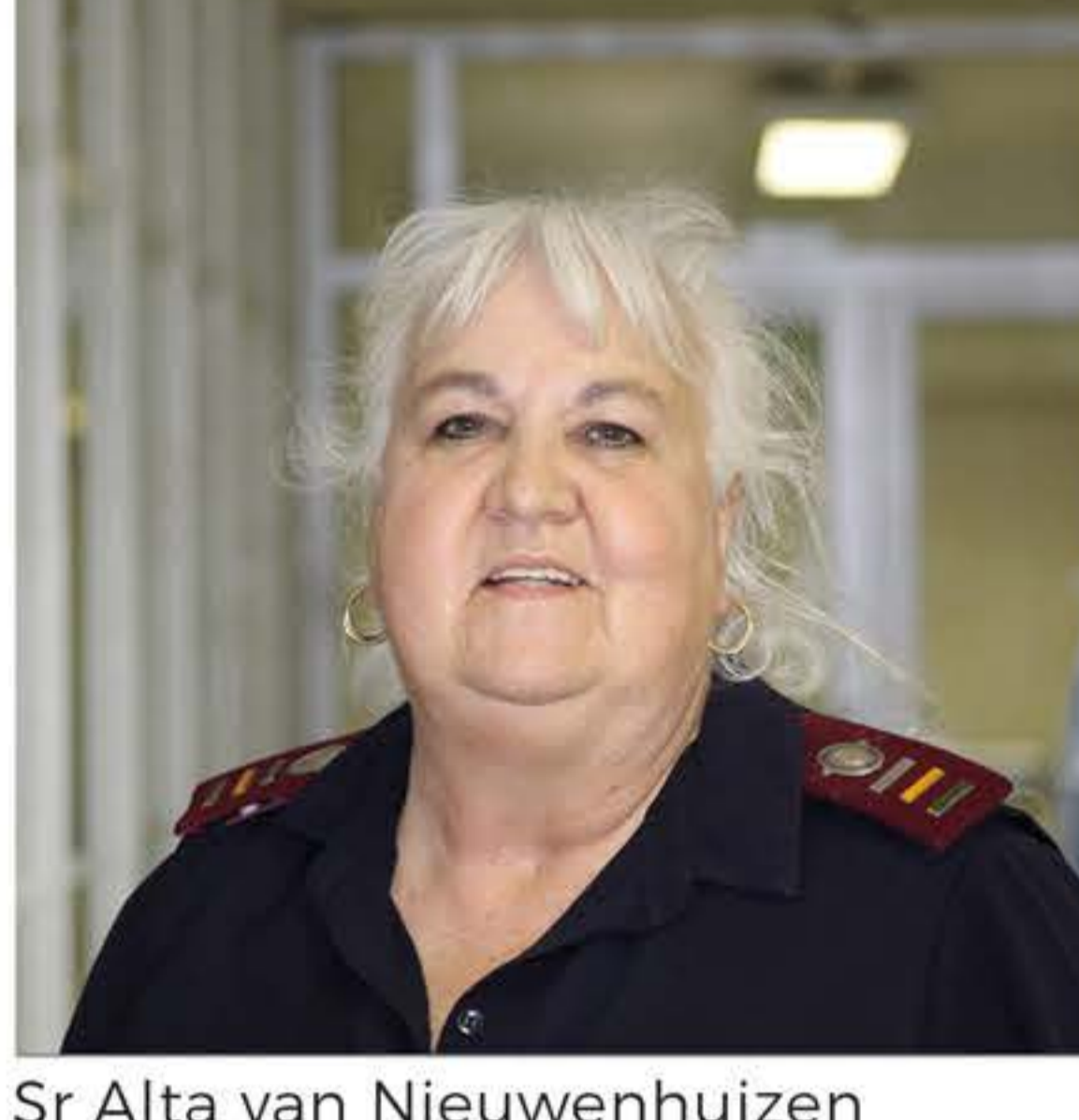
